

Exhibits, Display, Bulletin Boards and Pamphlet Racks

The Library uses exhibit and display space, bulletin boards and pamphlets to promote its goals of public education, collection building and cultural programming. Library-produced displays and materials present a range of points of view and do not advocate a single approach.

Library facilities are also available to the public for display and distribution of materials. These facilities may not be used for commercial purposes. Display of materials does not constitute endorsement of the views of the exhibitor by the Library. Space is available to the public on a first-come, first-served basis, and use is subject to the approval by the Library Director. All materials must be dated and the Library reserves the right to limit the duration of an exhibit and the frequency of the use of library space by an individual or group.

Art exhibits are arranged by the Somerset Library Art Committee. The committee reviews artists' work and selects artists for exhibit based on artistic merit. Priority is given to regional artists.

The library is not responsible for items that are damaged or stolen.
